Award winners receive a handsome plaque and are recognized at the ABS graduation ceremony (Saturday May 14, 9:00 a.m., Kansas Union Ballroom). This is a wonderful opportunity for us to celebrate your achievements with your friends and family members attending your graduation.

If you meet the minimum qualifications (above), we strongly encourage you to apply.

- Current resume or vita
- Current KU Degree Progress Report (DPR)
